



Privacy Policy

It is the policy of Shadyside Presbyterian Church (hereinafter "Church") to protect your personal privacy. Because your use of the Church website (www.shadysidepres.org) (referred to as "Site" herein) indicates your acceptance of the Church Privacy Policy, please review this Privacy Policy carefully. Church may change this Privacy Policy at any time by posting revisions to the Church Site. This Privacy Policy shall be applicable to any person or entity that directly or indirectly uses the Site or the Services ("Users").

Terms defined in the Church [Terms of Use](#) shall have the same meaning in this Privacy Policy.

INFORMATION COLLECTION AND USE

Church is the sole owner of the information collected on the Site. It uses collected information to provide or improve Services for Users, and, as more particularly set forth below, it may use collected information to contact Users for a variety of reasons, including, without limitation, obtaining information from Users regarding their use of the Site and Services and ways Church can improve them, and to send information to them regarding Church, its Services, or its Partners, such as promotions and events. This information is used in ways Church determines appropriate in its sole discretion, and it reserves the right to do so. Church will not sell or rent personally identifiable information to anyone, and it will not disclose any collected information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement.

Church collects personally identifiable information when you register for a Church account, when you use certain Church products or services, and when you visit Site pages. Church may also receive personally identifiable information from its business partners.

When you register with the Church, we ask for personally identifiable information including, but not limited to, your name, email address, address, zip code, and phone number. Once you register with Church and sign in to its services, you are not anonymous to the Church. Church also automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, Church cookie information, and the page you requested.

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. Non-personal identification information may include the browser name, the type of computer and technical information about Users' means of connection to our Site, such as the operating system and the Internet service provider utilized and other similar information.

FINANCIAL TRANSACTION INFORMATION

Church requests information from a User on the Site if the User performs a financial transaction with Church. In this case, a User must provide information including, but not limited to, name, address, and financial information, along with credit card information or bank account information.

Church may use a third-party intermediary to perform the transaction processing. This intermediary is solely a link in the distribution chain, and uses the information provided for the sole purpose of processing the transaction.

COOKIES

Church employs the use of Cookies to collect information about Users and their use of the Site. "Cookies" are small computer files that the Site transfers to your computer that allow Church to know how often you visit the Site and the activities you conduct while on the Site. Third parties, such as advertisers, may also use Cookies when you select their advertisements or links from the Site. However, Church has no access to or control over these Cookies.

INFORMATION SHARING AND DISCLOSURE

Church will not sell or rent Users' personally identifiable information to anyone. Church may send personally identifiable information about Users to other companies or people when:

Church has User's consent to share the information; Church needs to share User's information to provide the product or service User has requested; Church needs to send the information to companies who work on behalf of Church to provide a product or service to User (unless Church informs User otherwise, these companies do not have any right to use the personally identifiable information Church provides to them beyond what is necessary or appropriate in Church's discretion to assist Church); Church responds to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process; or Church finds that User's actions on Site violate the Church Terms of Service or any of Church usage guidelines for specific Services.

Church may share aggregated demographic information with Church partners and advertisers. This is not linked to any personal information that can identify any individual person.

LINKS

This Site may contain links to other sites. Please be aware that Church is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. Church encourages Users to be aware when they leave the Site and to read the privacy statements of each and every site that collects personally identifiable information. This Privacy Policy applies solely to information collected by this Site.

ACCESSING AND CHANGING YOUR INFORMATION

Users can view and update their personal information at any time by signing in to the User account on the Site and changing the User profile. Certain changes may require approval or acceptance from the Church Site administrator or other Church staff.

OPT-OUT

Church needs to be able to communicate at times with all Users, and therefore it reserves the right to contact Users. Users who no longer wish to receive the Church newsletter or promotional materials from our partners may opt-out of receiving these communications by following the instructions in the emails.

SECURITY

User registration or account information is password-protected for User privacy and security. The security of Church account relies on User's protection of User's Church password. Any disclosure of User's password to a third party may result in access to User's registration or account information or execution of transactions. Church uses industry-standard SSL-encryption to protect data transmissions of financial and certain other information. Financial information is stored in encrypted form on computers that are not publicly accessible via the Internet.

Church will never request User's log-in ID or password via any email message or over the telephone. If User receives such an email or call, please forward the entire message or information about any phone call immediately to webmaster@shadysidepres.org. User should never provide Site log-in ID or password to anyone via email or phone.

CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY

Church may amend this policy from time to time. If it makes any substantial changes in the way it uses Users' personal information, Church will notify Users by posting an announcement on the Site.

ACCEPTANCE OF THIS POLICY

By using this Site, User signifies acceptance of this policy and terms of service. If User does not agree to this policy, please do not use the Site. User's continued use of the Site following the posting of changes to this policy will be deemed User's acceptance of those changes.
