The Apostle Paul was really good at saying things over and over and over and over.

Paul had important news and stories and advice to share. He wrote letters to people in towns like Ephesus, Corinth, Galatia, Philippi, and Rome, Paul's letters encouraged people to love god, form churches, and share the stories of Jesus with others.

The letter Paul wrote to the people of Rome is what we know as the book of Romans in the New Testament.

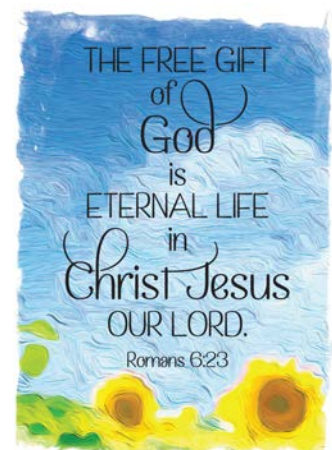
The Romans passage we read today is one of those times where Paul seems to keep saying the same thing over and over. If you listen to the whole thing, you might get confused.

Here's what Paul is trying to say:

We all have choices to make and those choices come with consequences. Make good choices.

Consequences can be good or bad and it is up to us to choose what we will do. Paul teaches us that when we choose to live the way Jesus taught us, then we will live a holy life. That is a really good consequence.

Our scripture readings today are both from the Old and new Testaments: Romans 6:12-23 and Psalm 13.

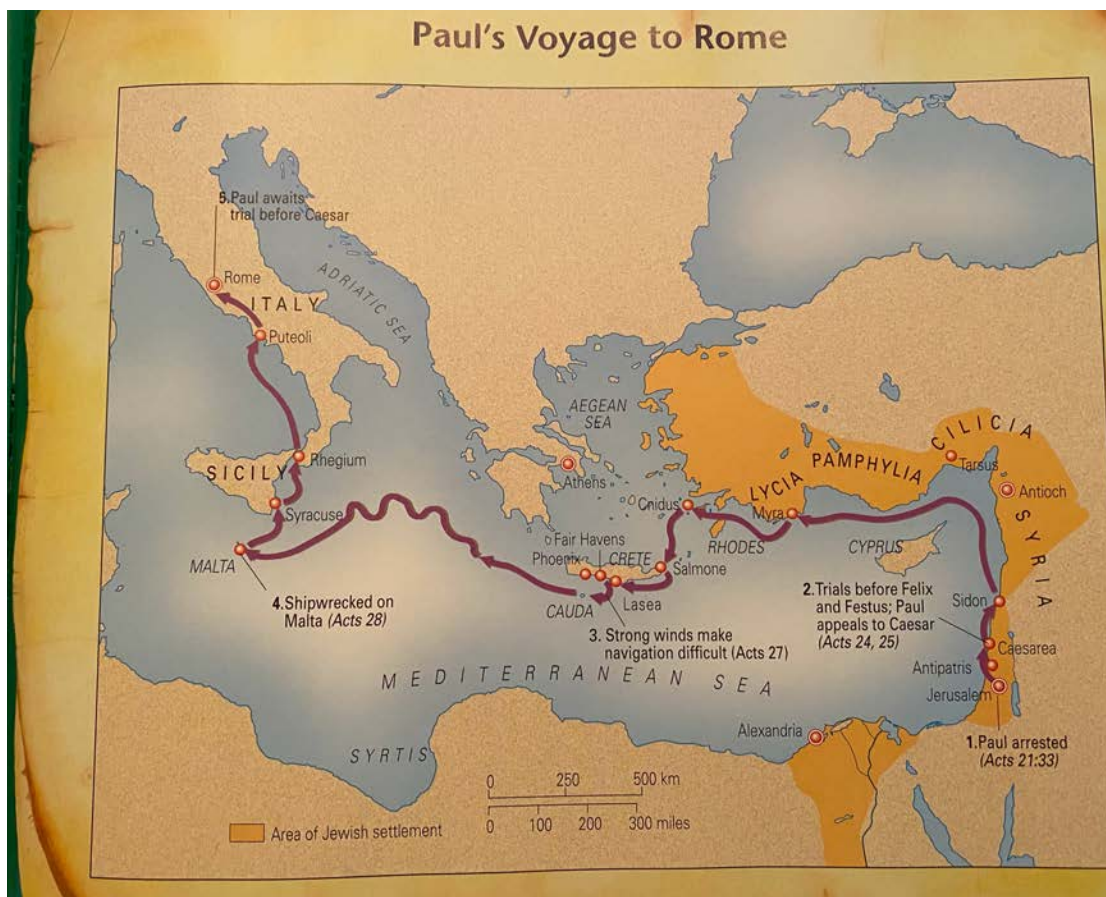


Can you find these bible passages in your bible? If you don't know what all the words and numbers mean, use this as your guide:

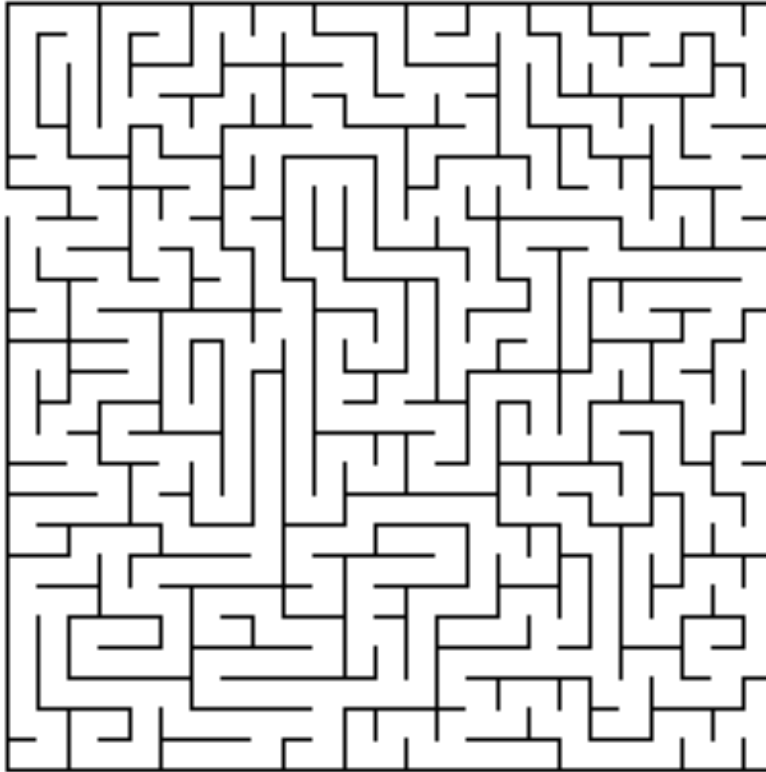
Something to ponder
