

## About This Morning's Music

Malcolm Boyle (1902-1976) was educated at Queen's College, Oxford, and was later appointed an international examiner for the Royal Schools of Music. "Thou, O God," is his best-known composition. For many years, no published edition was available; the piece only existed in manuscript form, having been written down from memory by a chorister at Chester Cathedral under Boyle.

Dr. John C. Walker served as the Minister of Music at Shadyside Presbyterian Church from 1992 to 2004. Following earlier distinguished tenures at The Riverside Church in the City of New York and at Shadyside, he is Minister of Music Emeritus at Brown Memorial Presbyterian Church in Baltimore. A Past President and Fellow of the American Guild of Organists, Dr. Walker is Professor of Organ at the Peabody Institute of Music.
