Moses + Elijah + Jesus = _____?

In our bible story and message today, we hear about a time Peter, James, and John witnessed something awesome that happened to Jesus on the top of a mountain. It was amazing and confusing and the three disciples tried to make sense of it.

In his sermon, Dr. Dalles will help explore this mountaintop experience. To help you understand a little about what's going on, it might help to know:

- Moses lived long before Jesus was born. Jesus heard the stories of Moses in his synagogue just like we hear bible stories in our church. God chose Moses to lead God's people. God gave Moses the Ten Commandments, or God's Laws, and those were the same Laws Jesus followed.
- Elijah was a prophet and he lived long before Jesus was born. Just like with Moses, Jesus had heard the stories of Elijah in his synagogue. Not everyone in Elijah's time knew about God, so Elijah shared God's messages with them. Many people became God followers because of Elijah.
- When it came time for Moses and Elijah to die, God didn't let Moses and Elijah die naturally. God took them directly into heaven. God's people knew Moses and Elijah were very special servants for God.



Our bible readings are from three different places in the bible:

- 2 Kings 2:12 (OT)
- Psalm 50:1-6 (OT)
- Mark 19:9-15

Seeing Moses, Elijah, and Jesus together on the mountaintop helped the disciples understand Jesus was part of God's plan all along. God spoke and said, "This is my Son. I love him. Listen to him." It was like a big puzzle finally came together.
