Happy Psalm Day!

Wait! What? Do you mean “Happy Sunday” or is “Psalm Day” a thing?

Psalm Day isn't actually a special day in the church year, but if you pay close attention to our worship service today, you would think today is Psalm Day.

Not only is our Call to Worship based on a Psalm, but these elements of our service are based on Psalms as well:

- The Orison (the sung prayer at the beginning of the service)
- Two anthems by our Chancel Choir
 - Ecce Quam Bonum (means “Behold How Good”)
 - Behold, Now Praise the Lord
- Both Scripture readings
- Pastor Lynn's sermon



That's a lot of Psalms in one service! Can you draw a line to match the Psalm with the worship element? (Hint: You'll need to look at the Worship Bulletin to find the answers.)

What is a Psalm, anyway?

The Deep Blue Kids Bible has a great explanation for what the *Book of Psalms* is all about:

Psalms contains 150 songs and hymns written by many different people. Some are songs of praise and thanks. Others are songs asking for help or forgiveness. Psalms helps people talk with and worship God...

The Psalms were written thousands of years ago, but they still inspire God's people to sing and pray today...God's people all over the world and throughout history have read Psalms to learn to sing and pray. This book helps us to worship God with songs and words of praise.

Psalm 107


If you completed the matching puzzle on page 1, you know Pastor Lynn's sermon is based on Psalm 107.
