A Little Bible Background


The Deep Blue Kids Bible offers these “Things You’ll Discover” about 2 Corinthians and Mark:

- **2 Corinthians** – This second letter to Christians in the city of Corinth continues the message Paul started in 1 Corinthians. Paul told people to quit being self-centered and get along. He also gave reasons why the Corinthians should listen to his message.
- **Mark** – The book of Mark is an action-packed summary of the things Jesus said and did, beginning with Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist and ending with Jesus' resurrection. This book helps people learn important truths about Jesus.
