What is Reformation?

Have you ever used Play-Doh or clay? Maybe you have found a packet of Model Magic in today's worship bag. One of the neat things about clay, and things like it, is you can make something and then smooch it up and make something different. You *form* one things and then *re-form* it, making something new, but with the same material.



Reformation Sunday is a day to celebrate the birthday of the Protestant Church, which is the branch of Christianity to which Presbyterianism belongs. It's a long story and one you will learn about as you get older. You can also *Google* it or read about it in a library book.

For now, the best way to describe Reformation is to say Christians are all Christ followers, but we don't all believe exactly the same things or do exactly the same things. The Reformation started way back in Europe in the 1500's and *re-formed* the way certain churches understand and worship God. Our church follows this *reformed* way of thinking.

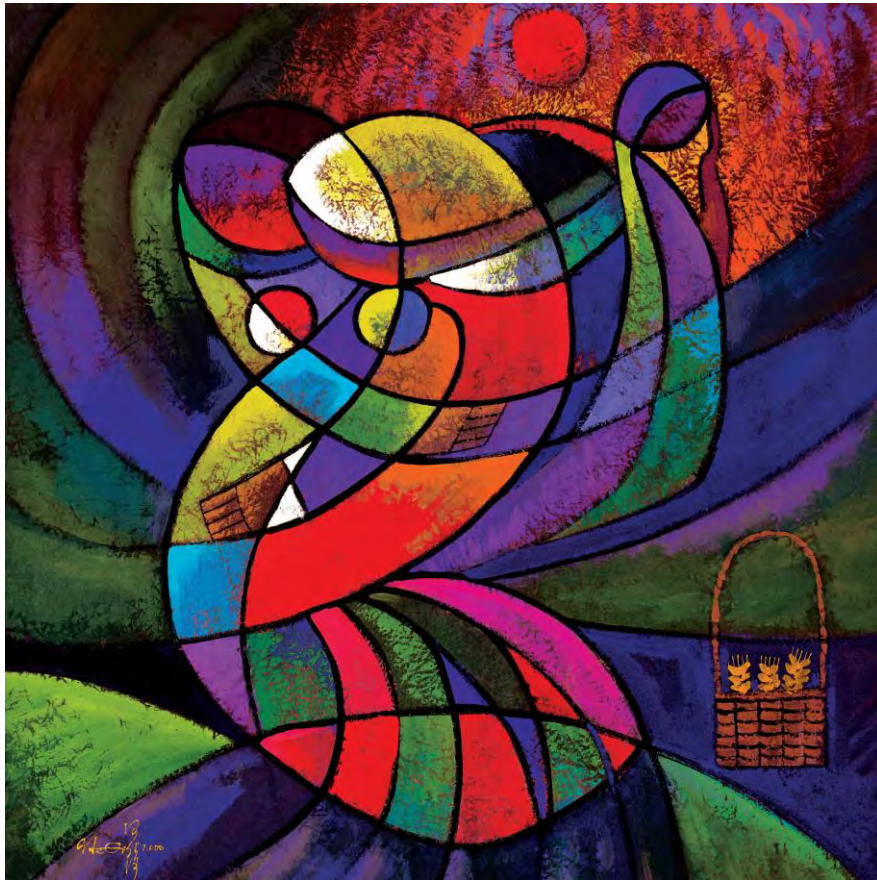

Wondering

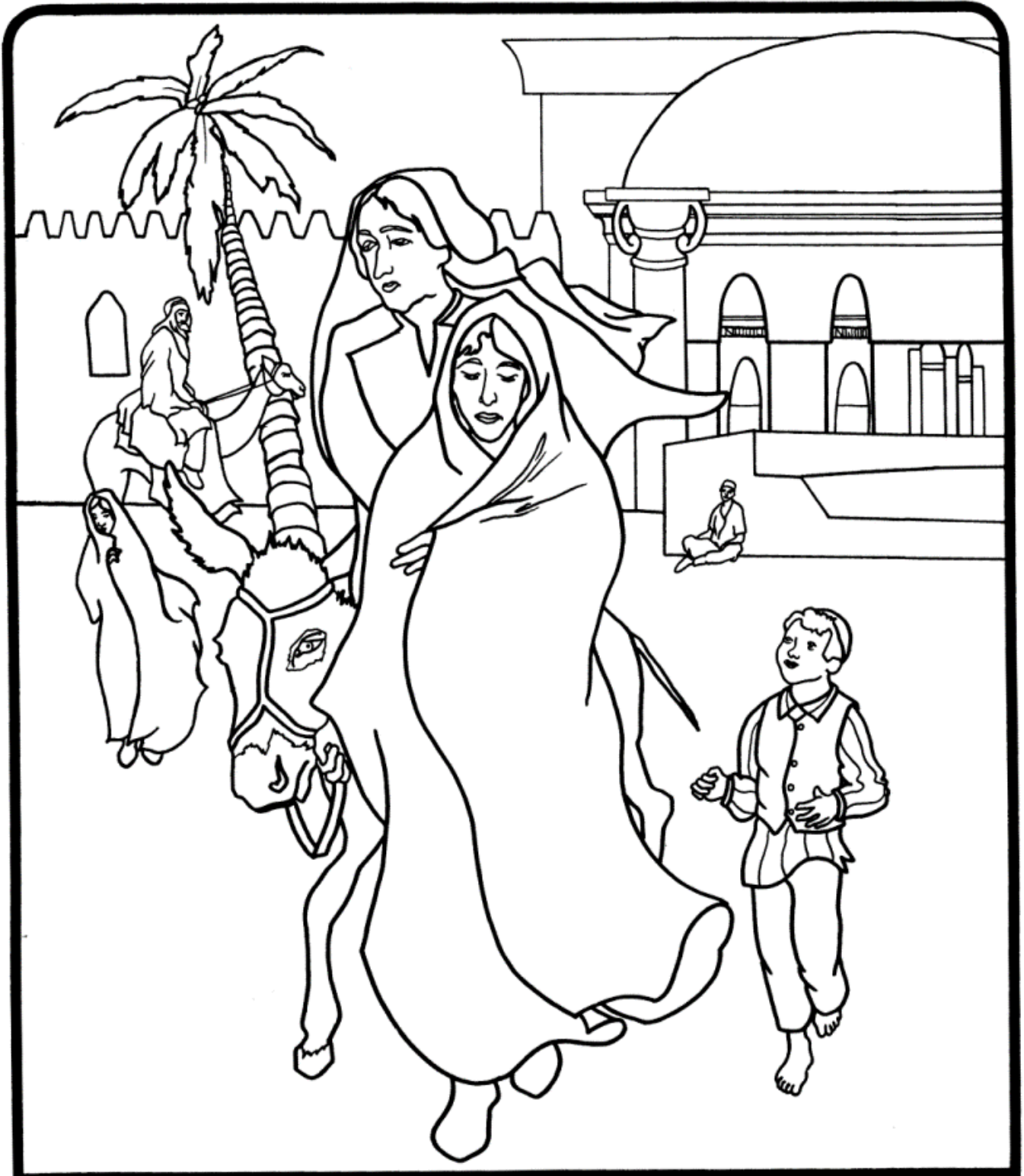
I wonder which person is which.
