

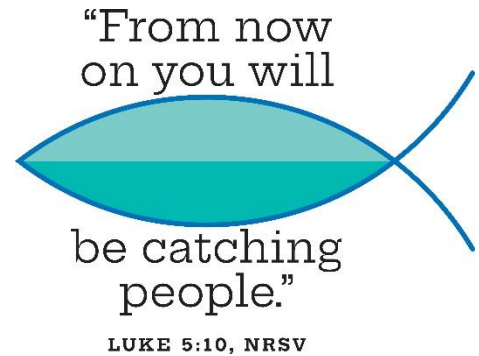

Let's go fishing!

Jesus had just finishing a full day of teaching a preaching. So many people came to hear Jesus. The crowd was so close to him, Jesus almost backed-up and stepped right into the Sea of Galilee! Thankfully, a fishing boat came to shore and Jesus got permission to speak from the boat where he had more room. The crowds were able to see and hear him so much better!

Imagine how confused the fishermen must have been when Jesus told them to go back out on the lake and fish some more. They had already spent the night fishing and caught nothing. Because they were amazed by what Jesus preached, they listened to him and went back out onto the sea.

Today, Pastor Austin will help us explore what happened when the fishermen listened to Jesus and followed him. We will learn what it means to "catch people" instead of catching fish.

What is Communion and what I am supposed to do?

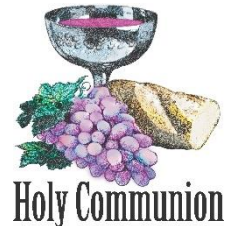
What is it?

Communion is a time of sharing and remembering. In our church, we invite all those who love and trust Jesus to participate in communion. Jesus shared special meals with his friends and disciples, but the most special meal he shared with them was the night before Jesus died.



Jesus wanted his disciples to have a special way of remembering him, so when they had their meal, Jesus told his followers the bread was to help them remember his body and that the wine (juice from grapes) was to help them remember Jesus' blood.

We still have this special remembering meal today and we call it Communion. The bread reminds us Jesus was a living person with a body and we "break" the bread to remember Jesus. The juice reminds us Jesus died for us; he died on a cross, so we remember Jesus' blood, like the dark juice we drink. Communion is a meal of remembering.



Our pastors help us to understand this by the words they say. You can follow along in the bulletin so you know when it is your turn to pray and sing.

What do I do with this little cup thing?



Listen for our pastor's instructions on when and how to peel back the plastic on the top of the cup. The wafer is right under the clear plastic, so do that first. Peel back the next layer to drink the grape juice. You should eat the wafer and drink the juice when you are ready. We wait for everyone else to be served and then follow the pastor's example on when we eat the bread and drink the juice. When you are finished, you should put the plastic cup in the holding place in the pew – near the bible and hymnal.

What do I do during the quiet time?

If you are done before other people, you can listen to the music. This is also a great time to pray. You can say thankful prayers or you can tell God you are sorry for things you may have done that were not the best choices. God listens to our prayers. Honest.

When communion is over, we all say the Lord's Prayer together and then sing a hymn or song of praise to thank God for giving us Jesus.


