

“Love Your Neighbor as Yourself”

Jesus was an incredible teacher. Many people asked him questions. Often, Jesus answered the questions by using stories called, “parables.” Parables are stories that teach important lessons. In Luke 10:25-37, we hear a conversation between a person and Jesus:



Legal Expert: Teacher (Jesus), what must I do to gain eternal life?

Jesus: What is written in the Law? What does God say to do?

Legal Expert: You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and you should love your neighbor as you love yourself.


Jesus: You have given the right answer. Do this and you shall live.

Legal Expert: And who is my neighbor?

In typical Jesus mode, Jesus answers the person’s question with a story. That story, and what it means, is the theme of our worship service today.

It’s not always easy to do what God asks of us. The important thing is that we keep trying.

Where in the Word is the Word?



The Word can mean many things:

- The Word = God’s messages for God’s people
- The Word = Jesus, God’s Son
- The Word = The Bible, the story of God’s people
- The Word = A sermon or homily spoken


Reading & Listening Clues
